A Team player, good at building cross-team relationships. 	<p>The purpose of this position:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The purpose of Driver position is to ensure the safe conveyance of staff and supplies/materials/equipment to authorized destinations. The Driver is responsible for proper vehicle use, cleanliness/hygiene and roadworthiness and advises the line manager if some concerns/issues should be reviewed or fixed in the vehicles. <p>Further Roles and Responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drive at a speed with consideration for the safety of the passengers, other road users, the load and the technical state of the vehicle. Adhere to SND-Vehicle policy and traffic rules and regulations. Ensure maximum speed limit (80KM/Hr) is not passed at all times. Wear a seat-belt and ensuring that all passengers also wear their seatbelts at all times when the vehicle is in motion. Decide whether or not to attempt to cross a difficult section of road, to continue after a technical defect has been detected, or to delay the travel. Immediately notify the supervisor as well as the local authorities in case of any accident/incident in which is involved. Support staff members including but not limited to Finance, Logistics, Human Resources and programmes in the dispatching and collecting of wide range of documents, assets and materials as and when required. Keep driving license valid and ready for inspection. Make sure all necessary vehicle documents (e.g. insurance, registration documents, etc.) are present in the vehicle and up to-date. Ensure that they have the necessary travel permits and documents for each journey. Correctly fill in the vehicle logbook with details of each journey Ensure correct loading and unloading of the vehicle considering the maximum loading capacity, proper distribution and securing of the load. Keep the vehicle assigned to them clean and road-worthy Refuel the vehicle whenever necessary. Carry out the necessary daily and weekly vehicle check-ups as (in programme transport or vehicle policy) specified. Undertake other duties as required.
